Admission Requirements

- Minimum age: 14 years
- Maximum number of students: 25

German Course

- Recommended: 20 training units (TU = 45 minutes) per week (Monday to Friday) with max. 15 participants

Accommodation

- Host families (single or double rooms; course leader in a single room): students min. 16 years; Radolfzell: min. 15
- Residence (Berlin/Radolfzell) or youth hostels (single or double room, group studios/multi-bed rooms)

Services Included

- German course, placement test, course materials and certificate of participation
- Accommodation with breakfast, half board or full board
- Activity program and excursions
- Airport transfers
- One adult supervisor free of charge for groups with 15 or more participants
